Sample IEP Goals and Objectives

Student will demonstrate an increase in decoding skills by identifying root words (segmenting words) in compound words.

(objective) Given 48 root words, student will correctly match them to form 24 compound words with% accuracy as measured by teacher/therapist record keeping.
(objective) Given 24 compound words, student will correctly copy the printed words with% accuracy as measured by teacher/therapist record keeping.
(objective) Given 48 root words, student will independently combine them to form 24 compound words% accuracy as measured by teacher/therapist record keeping.
(objective) Given 24 compound word photos, student will independently write and correctly spell the compound words with% accuracy as measured by teacher/therapist record keeping.
(objective) Given a list of 24 compound words, student will read each word with% accuracy as measured by teacher/therapist record keeping.
The student will demonstrate the ability to articulate multi-syllable words given a list of 24 compound words.
(objective) Given 24 compound words, student will correctly identify the number of syllables in each word with% accuracy as measured by therapist record keeping.
(objective) Given 24 compound words, student will intelligibly produce each syllable in the compound word with% accuracy as measured by therapist record keeping.
